

itelligence AG announces preliminary figures for the third quarter and the first nine months of 2007

- **Revenues grow 16.4% in the first nine months to MEUR 135.9**
- **EBIT more than doubled to MEUR 7.8**
- **Forecasts for the full year at the upper end of the guidance**

Bielefeld (Germany), October 19, 2007 – itelligence AG, one of the leading international full-service IT providers for SAP, continued its positive performance of the first six months in Q3 2007. Revenues rose by 13.6% in the third quarter to MEUR 47.4, up from MEUR 41.7 in the previous year. As a result, itelligence achieves revenues of MEUR 135.9 on a nine-months basis, corresponding to growth of 16.4% compared with the previous year's figure of MEUR 116.8.

In addition, the earnings figures of itelligence AG developed positively: in the third quarter EBIT increased by around 48.0% from MEUR 2.0 to MEUR 3.0. The EBIT margin thus amounted to 6.3% (Q3 2006: 4.9%). This results in EBIT of MEUR 7.8 in the first nine months of 2007 (previous year: MEUR 3.8). The increase over nine months was thus around 105%. The EBIT margin for the first nine months of the current financial year was 5.7%, up from 3.3% in the comparative period of 2006.

Based on the excellent key figures of Q3 and sound orders on hand, itelligence confirms its forecasts for financial year 2007. itelligence therefore expects to achieve both revenues ranging between MEUR 180 to MEUR 190 (revenues 2006: MEUR 163.8) and EBIT ranging between MEUR 10 and MEUR 12 (EBIT 2006: MEUR 7.1) at the upper end of the guidance.
